

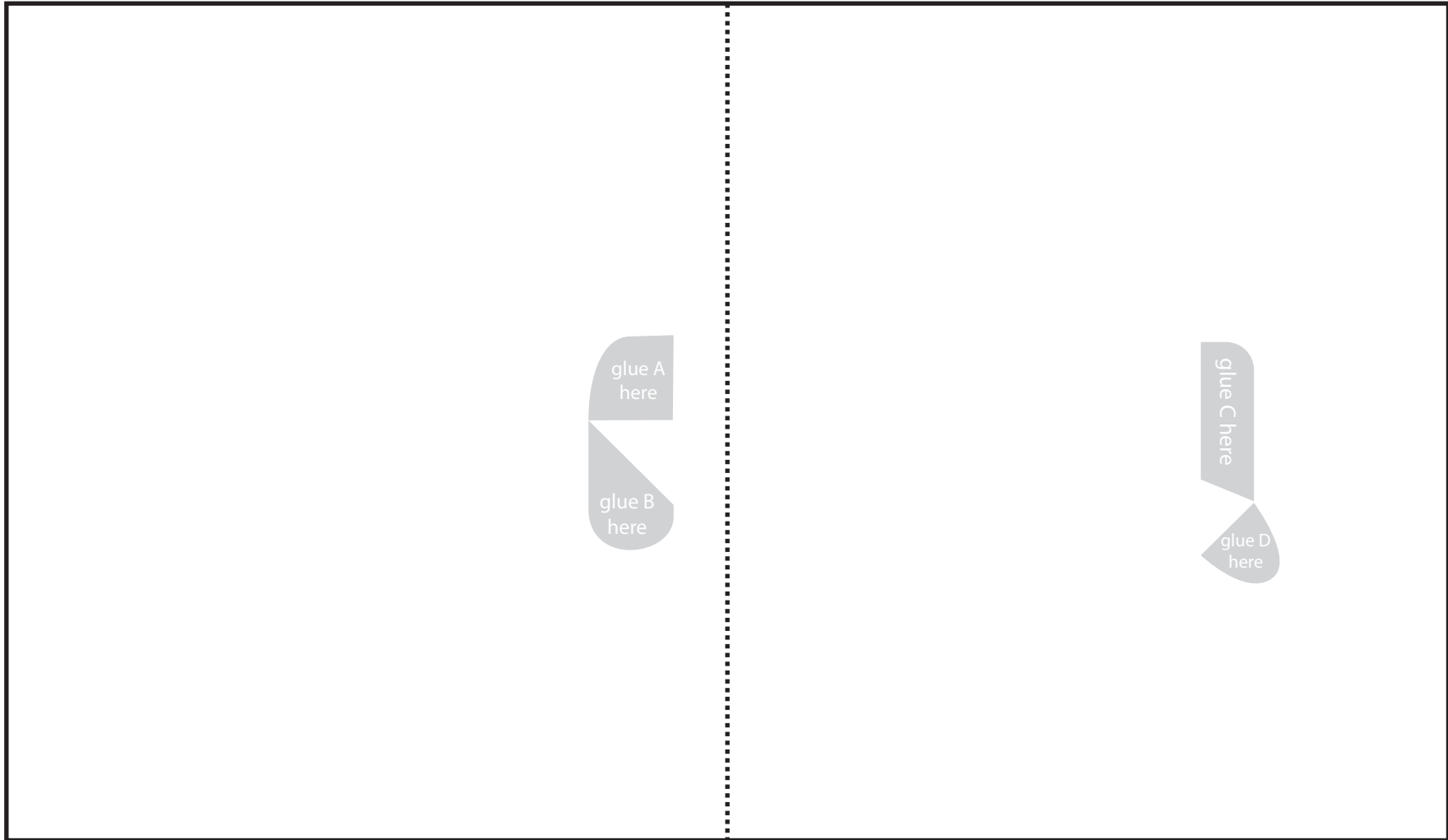
Coelacanths:

- Coelacanths are large fish that were believed to have gone extinct 66 millions years ago, until a live specimen was caught in 1938.
- Though they still exist, coelacanths are very rare and critically endangered.
- They can grow to over 6 feet long and weigh up to 200 pounds.

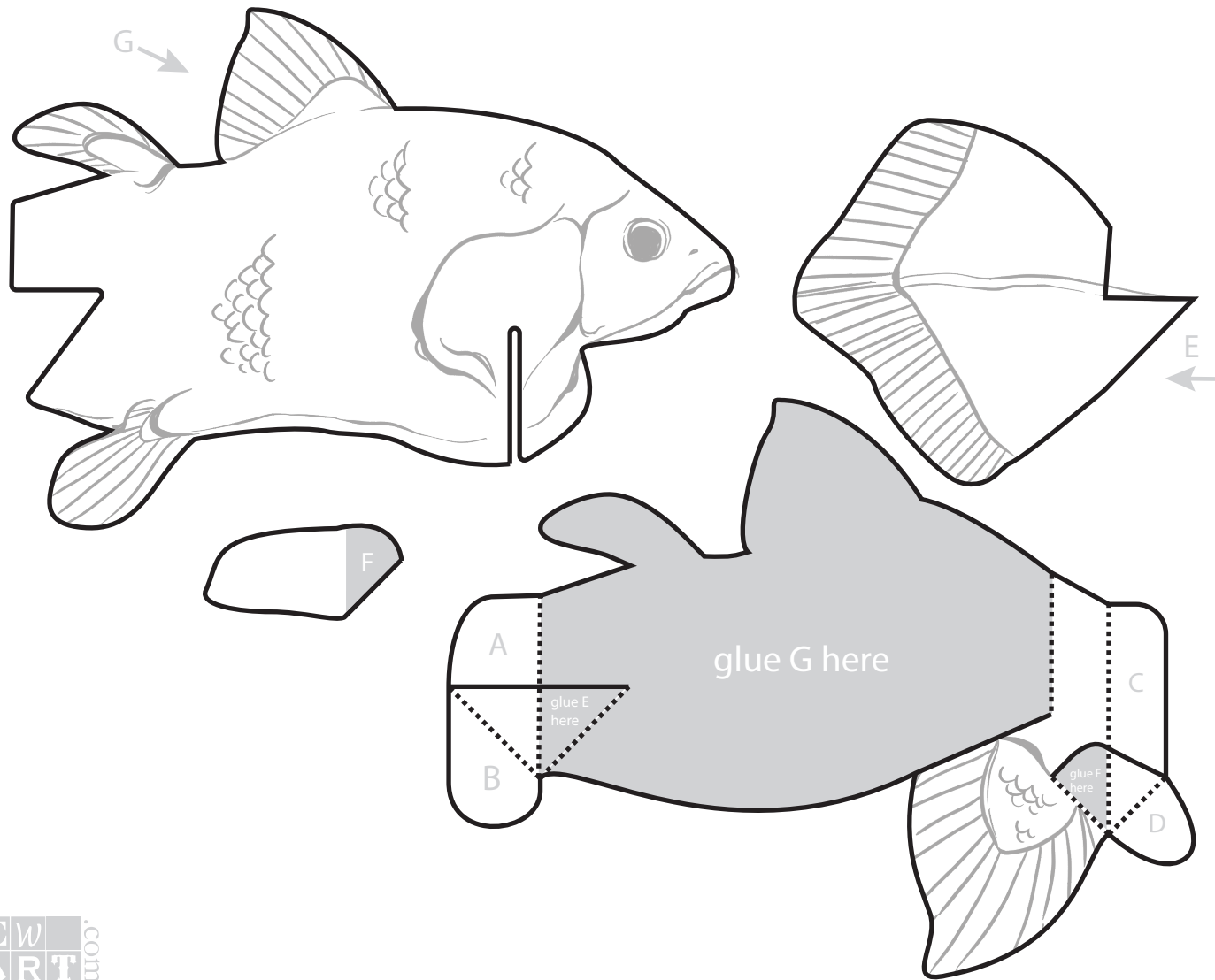
