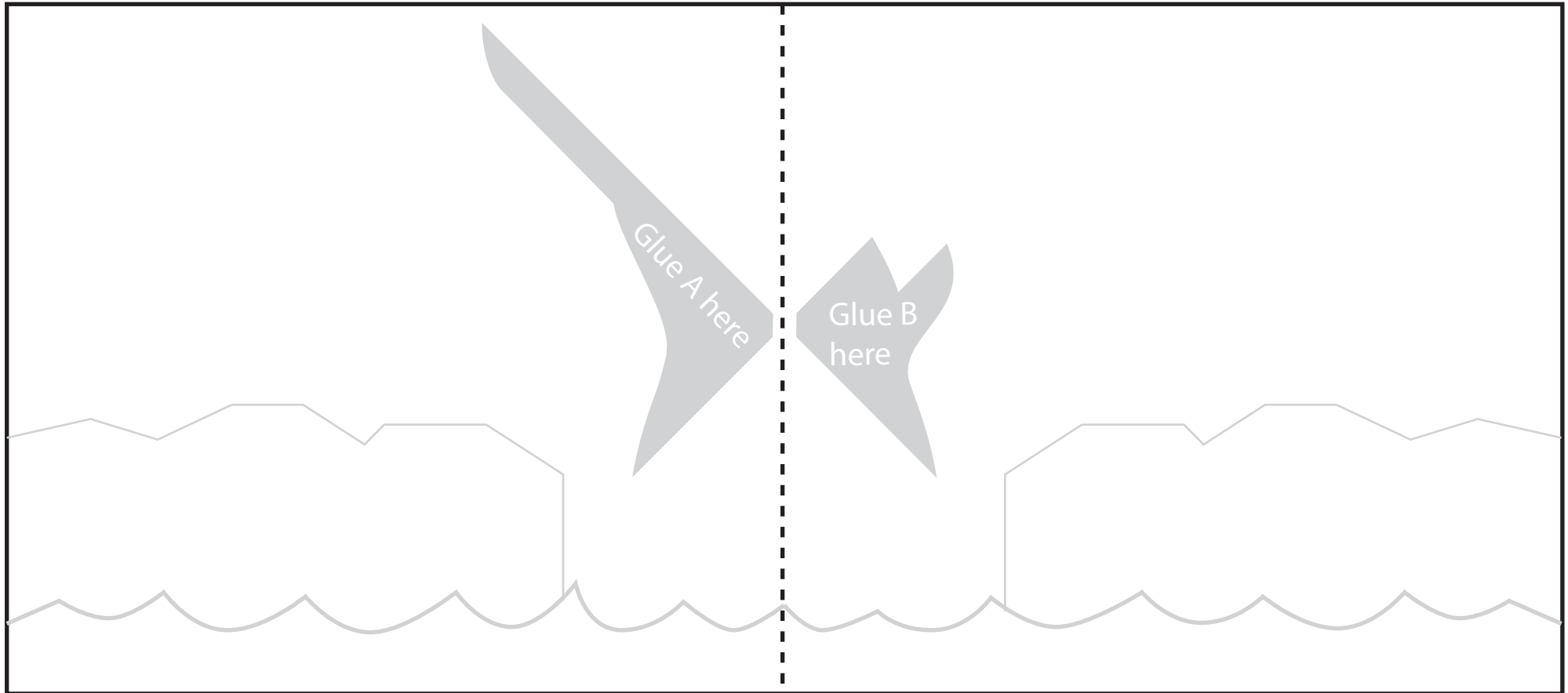


## The Colossus of Rhodes:

- This statue was built in 280 BC in the city of Rhodes, to honor the Greek sun god Helios.
- Though it no longer stands, it was estimated to be 108 feet tall.
- The Colossus of Rhodes stood on either side of a waterway, and ships passed beneath it.

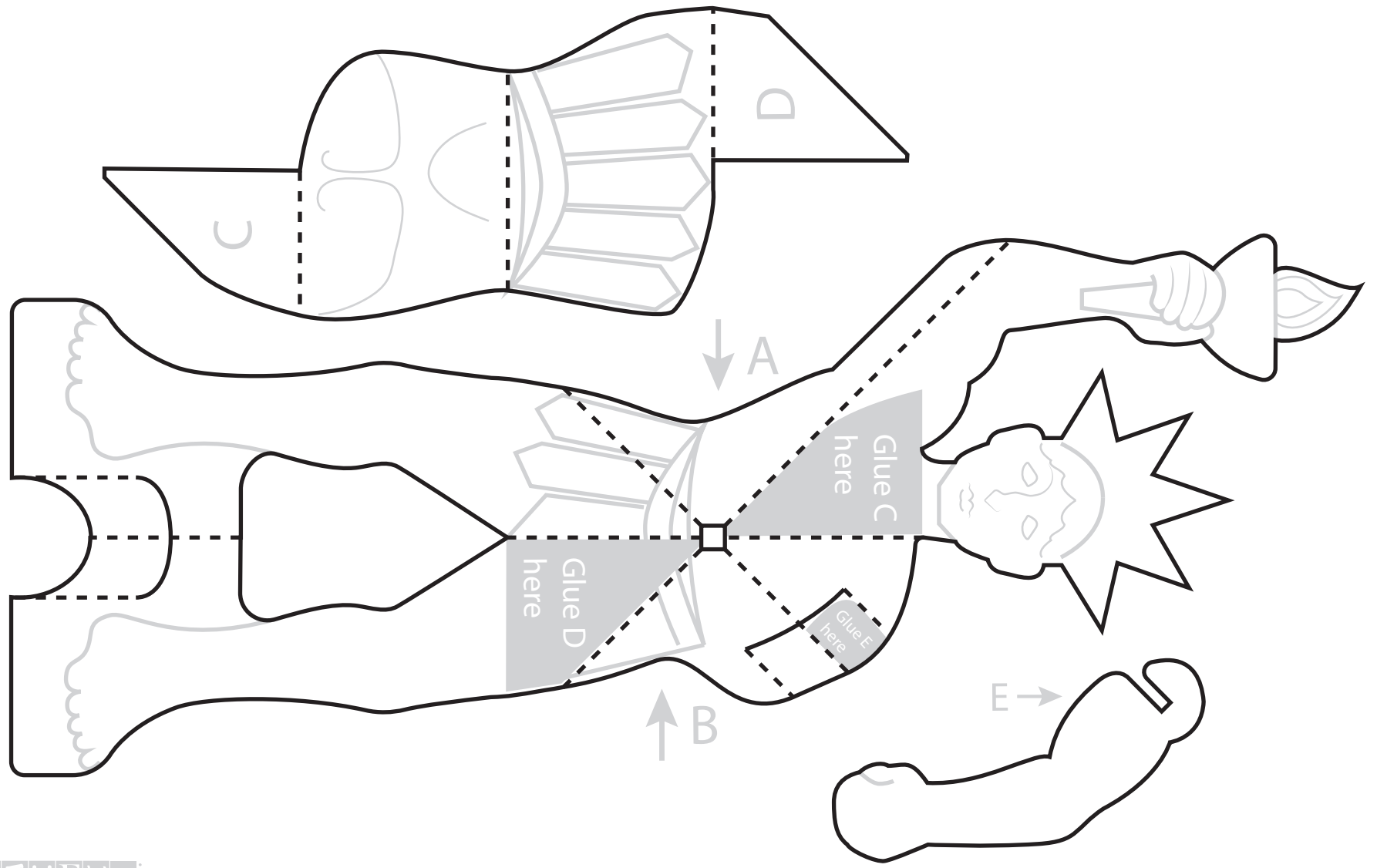
